**ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

All property located adjacent to the sewer line extension or with legal access within 500 feet to the sewer line extension, running the length of Old Orchard Lane, all within the SW ¼ of Section 14, T. 50N., R.4W., Town of Bayfield, Bayfield County, Wisconsin.
